









HOW FAR DO YOU TRAVEL TO GET TO THE ATLANTIC BEACH PARK YOU MOST FREQUENTLY VISIT?








HOW IMPORTANT DO YOU BELIEVE PARKS ARE TO THE QUALITY OF LIFE IN ATLANTIC BEACH?









Just need slow improvement.



WHAT PART OF THE CITY DO YOU LIVE IN?




WHAT IS YOUR GENDER?


WHAT IS YOUR AGE?
