Machine Recount ordered for the race of Mayor of Atlantic Beach and Bartram Springs Community Development District Seat 2 Supervisor

JACKSONVILLE – The Duval County Canvassing Board has certified the first unofficial results of the November 8, 2022 General Election. Both the Atlantic Beach Mayoral race and the Bartram Springs Community Development District (CDD) Seat 2 Supervisor race will require a recount because the margin between the opponents is less than one half of one percent (F.S. s. 102.141(7)).

The Board has ordered a machine recount for Tuesday, November 15, 2022 to be held at 9:30 a.m. at the Supervisor of Elections' Election Center located at 1 Imeson Park Blvd, Jacksonville, FL 32218. In the event that the results of either race are within ¼ of one percent or less, the Canvassing Board will order a manual recount of the overvotes and undervotes for all the ballots in the application jurisdiction for race(s) at issue (F.S. s. 102.166). If needed, the manual recount is expected to begin immediately following the machine recount determination.
