- Need to Clearly communicate Safety related concerns
- Provide Landscaping that is easy to maintain and looks great
- Each Access is Unique, one size does not fit all
- Does every access need Seating, Trash Can and Shower?



- Tailor Signage & Amenities to each Access
- Single Sign or Multiple Signs?
- Positive verbiage where possible
- Trash can(s)
- Shower
- Seating
- Landscaping with Native or Salt Tolerant Plants
 - Develop Plant Palette
 - Develop general Landscape Guidance
