



Frequently Asked Questions



Where is the Atlantic Beach Dog Park?

The park is located on Aquatic Drive next to Sunrise Community Church, across from Beaches Aquatic Center. The address is 268 Aquatic Drive.



How do I become a member?

You can download forms from the City of Atlantic Beach website at www.coab.us/dogpark or pick them up at City Hall. You will need proof of up-to-date shots and spay / neutering. The membership fee is \$50 per year for the first dog and \$25 for each additional dog, up to three (Sales Tax will be added to all fees.) Memberships are on a calendar year basis, expiring on December 31 each year. Member fees are prorated for partial year memberships (see [Fee Schedule](#)). No more than three dogs may be under the care of one person. Forms may be submitted and fees paid at City Hall, 800 Seminole Road.



Why do I have to pay to use the park?

In order to ensure a safe, well-maintained park, and have the means to enforce the rules, a controlled access system is in place. Membership fees are used for maintenance and improvements to the park. Colored tags will be issued for each “member” dog, with a new color tag issued each year to provide easy recognition for authorized users.



Can I bring a visiting, non-registered (“guest” or “visitor”) dog to the park?

*****Visiting dogs must meet shot and spay/neuter requirements*****

A **guest** is defined as someone using the park with a member who already has a membership/access card. A \$5/day (plus sales tax) user fee is paid at City Hall. No tag is required. A receipt from the Cashier’s Office serves as documentation of legal use of the park.

A **visitor** is defined as someone who doesn’t have a friend/relative with a membership/access card but wants to use the park on a daily/weekly basis. A \$10/day (plus sales tax) user fee is paid at City Hall. At the time of payment, the visitor will receive a dog tag and access card. A slotted drop box is provided at the Dog Park for depositing the access card after the last visit.



Are there separate areas for small and large dogs?

YES, there is a separate fenced, gated area for small dogs, although any dog may use the large dog area at the owner’s discretion.



Is there fresh drinking water?

There is fresh drinking water for the dogs and their escorts (non-filtered, non-chilled tap water.)



Are there restrooms at the park?

There are no restrooms on site.

Park amenities include a swimming pond, dog rinsing station, fresh water drinking stations, poop bag dispensers, trash cans, and benches. Your dog must be off leash once inside the park. Hours of operation are 7:30 a.m. to dusk. The park may be closed for maintenance as needed.
